Consider This...

- You can make a 12 or 18 month calendar.
- Calendars can start in ANY month.
- Calendars come in sizes: 11x8½", 12x12", 12x18", A4 and A5.
(Choices will vary by store.)
- There are lots of colors available!



Calendar Tips...

- Minimum number of photos for a 12-month calendar: **13** (don't forget the cover!)
- Optimum number of photos for a 12-month calendar: **13-49**
- Maximum number of photos for a 12-month calendar: **73** (6 per month + cover)
